2011 Local Rules

1. Through the green, a ball which is embedded in its own pitch mark in the ground, other than a hazard or bunker, may be lifted without penalty, cleaned, and dropped as near as possible to where it lay but not nearer the hole. USGA App. 1-3
2. The following are winter rules: Without penalty, a ball in the fairway of the hole being played, may be lifted, cleaned, and placed within one club-length of its original position no nearer to the hole.
3. Ruts, gouges, holes made by the course superintendent or equipment, french drains or ditches visually lined in stone are ground under repair. Drop at the nearest point of relief not nearer the hole. (Rule 25-1)
4. A ball lying outside a fence, white stakes, and or inside edge of all roads is considered out of bounds.
5. In a bunker, stones lying within six inches of your ball may be removed without penalty. If your ball is moved in removing the stones the ball shall be replaced without penalty.
6. A ball coming to rest in mulched areas around trees must be played as it lies. Relief may be taken only under Rule 28 (unplayable lies).

However, free relief must be taken if your ball comes to rest in any flowerbed or a newly planted tree identified by supportive stakes and or strings.

7. If your stance or swing is affected by either the wooden slats in the bunkers or steps in a bunker you should proceed under Rule 24-2-b (ii) regarding an immovable obstruction in a bunker. The player shall lift without penalty, and drop the ball at the nearest point of relief not nearer the hole except that the nearest point of relief must be in the bunker.
8. A ball coming to rest on the cart path beside the rock wall on hole #16 must be dropped without penalty at the nearest point of relief no closer to the hole. If the drop requires a person to drop above the rock wall they have the option of dropping at the nearest point of relief no closer to the hole at a point that will not be above the rock wall. There is no relief for a ball that comes to rest on the hill above the rock wall unless the wall interferes with that person's stance or swing.
9. Native Grass Areas – A ball may be played from native areas as it lies. A ball lost or unplayable within native area may be played (under penalty of one stroke) by dropping a ball outside native area within two club-lengths of where the ball last crossed native area. This drop must not be closer to the hole.

10.Distance Measuring Devices: A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. However, if, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, wind-speed, temperature, etc.)the player is in breach of rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional functions are actually used.

Kenmure Country Club TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES

Each year Kenmure Country Club hosts the following tournaments for all full members: Spring Ringer, Ladies Member-Guest, Men's Member-Guest, Member-Member, Couples Member-Member, Club Championship, and Fall Ringer. In addition several couples' mixers are held during the year.

These guidelines are to provide Tournament Chairpersons and the Professional Staff with information concerning details of their responsibilities for various tournaments. Members of the Golf Activities Committee will be happy to answer any questions and assist the chairpersons when necessary. The Tournament Chairpersons are to promote the event, coordinate the awards dinner and assist the Professional Staff in areas that they request. The Professional Staff will be responsible for all golf-related tasks, and are invited to attend dinner following major tournaments.

In this booklet you will find the specific requirements, formats and fees for each tournament. The major tournaments are the Member Guest, Club Championship and Member - Member.

The **Member Tournament Chairpersons** will be responsible for the following activities:

- Coordinate the social event with the Club Manager or event coordinator.
- Determine the menu and cost as well as the location of the bar
- Handle publicity for the event in the Kenmure newsletter and by posters
- Meet with the Club Receptionist to develop seating charts
- Once the entries are closed, prepare a seating chart. The seating chart should not be posted until the beginning of the social hour. Ask the Receptionist to print nametags. The host couple will see that the nametags are handed out at the dinner.

With the exception of the Member/Member, you should prepare and post random seating by couples. For the Member/Member, seating charts should be organized by teams and their spouses, with women teams having precedent to seating with their partners and spouses in even years, and men teams having precedent to seating with their partners and spouses in odd years.

(Any individual canceling within the last 24 hours prior to the event will be charged for dinner.)

- Arrange for PA system at dinner
- Announce winners and prizes at Mixer events (if Golf Professional is not present)
- Submit winners' names to editor of Kenmure newsletter for major tournaments, not mixers
- Verify that Professional Staff faxes winners to the Times-News for major tournaments
- Prepare a brief report for the GAC on the event with problems or ideas

The Professional Staff will be responsible for the following activities:

- Determine format
- **Prepare and maintain the sign up sheets for golf and dinner.**
(Any person canceling for golf after the entry deadline will be charged the entry fee.)
- A list of those who have signed up for GOLF should be placed on the window of the Pro Shop two days prior to the deadline of entry and left until the entry deadline as a reminder for those who may have forgotten to sign up
- A list of those who have signed up for DINNER should be posted on the front window of the Pro Shop at the close of entry for the event and left there through the first round as a reminder to those who did not sign up for dinner.
- Select trophies for GAC review and determine amount of Pro Shop certificates
- Determine pairings and tee times
- Prepare scorecards and rules sheets
- Make sure all names are on the scoreboard, measuring tapes are in place, and lines drawn if needed
- Supervise the scoreboard
- Make announcements prior to the start of play
- Prepare list for presentation of winners and announce winners at major tournaments
- Submit results to Times-News

PUBLICITY:

Once the details are established, the announcement for the Kenmure Newsletter can be developed. This publicity should contain all pertinent details of the tournament in one month and a brief article on the upcoming event in the other month. These articles must be submitted to the editor of the newsletter by the 13th of the month prior to when the article should appear. Plans should be reviewed with the Golf Activities Committee at their monthly meeting. This review is for information purposes only, but it does provide the opportunity for others to offer helpful suggestions. When possible utilize the Kenmure website for publicity.

The newsletter article and website should contain the following items:

- Name, purpose, and deadline for entry
- Format and entry fee
- Date(s) and first tee time or time of shotgun
- Requirement to sign up in Pro Shop in person (no phone calls)
- Entry restrictions on handicaps
- Time of social hour will be 6 p.m. and dinner will be served at 7 p.m.
- Menu and cost of dinner
- Non-playing spouses are invited to dinner- cost for dinner only

Other publicity can include a poster for the bulletin boards (no larger in size than 8.5" x 14") and announcements made during awards presentations at earlier tournaments.

ENTRY FEES: (GOLF) Sweeps entry

- \$30 per person. (**Any Trophy Event**)
- Club Match Play Championship - \$20
- Ringer Tournaments - \$20 per person (\$10 for 9-Holer Ringer)
- Mixers or Wine, Nine, and Dine - \$5 per person.

Rain Out Policy: Entry Fees

- The golf entry fee for a two-day club tournament will not be reduced if inclement weather prevents two days of competition.

Tournament will revert to a one day event as no rain date will be scheduled.

ELIGIBILITY:

- All full members of Kenmure must have a USGA handicap, verified by the Club Professional, to play in all tournaments. The Club Professional will determine the handicap of guests in tournaments based on all available information. This will include recent scores sent to Professional prior to the tournament.
- Special restrictions apply to the Club Championship. To enter the championship flight, the entrant's handicap may not exceed 15 for men or 25 for 18-hole women. The Men's senior's championship flight is limited to those 65 or older.
- The maximum course handicap of 42 for men, 43 for 18-hole women, and 37 for 9-hole women.
- To participate in an 18-hole mixer the above standards must be met, but a 9-hole woman with a handicap of 23 or less (for 9 holes) can participate and will be given a maximum of 43 strokes. To participate in a 9-hole mixer or Wine, Nine, and Dine, all players must have a handicap of 37 or less for nine holes.

TOURNAMENT SCORE POSTING:

- The following club tournaments are designated to be posted as tournament scores: **The Golf Professional Staff will post all tournament scores for all members.**
 - Men's Member Guest
 - Member-Member
 - Club Championship
 - Ringer Tournaments (Round One Scores Only)

The following organization events are designated to be posted as tournament scores **The Golf Professional Staff will post all tournament scores for all members.**

MGA – MGA Championship

WGA – President's Cup (Best 2 Rounds of 3 will be posted)

TIE BREAKERS:

- In tournaments where names are placed on plaques, ties for first place are decided by a sudden-death playoff commencing on hole #1.
- All other ties are to be decided by USGA recommendations from the 2010-2011 USGA Rules of Golf Championship which reads as follows:
 - In either a scratch or handicap stroke-play competition, if a play-off of any type is not feasible, matching scorecards is recommended. The method of matching cards should be announced in advance. An acceptable method of matching cards is to determine the winner on the basis of the best score for the last nine holes. If the tying players have the same score for the last nine holes, determine the winner on the basis of the last six holes, last three holes, and finally the 18th hole. If such a method is used in a handicap stroke-play competition, one-half, one-third, one-sixth, etc. of the handicap should be deducted. Fractions should not be disregarded. If such a method is used in a competition with a multiple tee start, it is recommended that the last nine holes, last six holes, etc. is considered to be holes 10-18, 13-18, etc.
 - If the conditions of the competition provide that ties shall be decided over the last nine, last six, last three and last hole, they should also provide what will happen if this procedure does produce a winner.
- If a winner has not been declared after the above procedure is applied to the scorecards, the winner will be decided by using the number one handicap hole. If still no winner, the next handicap hole score will be used, etc. until a winner is declared. In mixed events the “men’s handicap” holes will be used for card playoff.
- In Ringer Tournaments only, ties will be broken by a card playoff. The winner will be decided by using the score on the number 1 handicap rating. If still no winner, the next handicap rating hole will be used, etc. until a winner is declared.

GENERAL:

- No requests for pairings or tee times should be honored. The handicap computer assigns Pairings and tee times randomly according to tournament format.
- A minimum of eight (8) participants in a specific flight is required for a tournament that will present a trophy (except the gross championship flights in Club Championship).

Tournament Tee Recommendations

NINE HOLE MIXERS or Wine, Nine and Dine – Men will play from the Blue Tees and Women will play from the Red Tees

18 HOLE MIXERS – Men will play from the Blue Tees and Women will play from the Red Tees

SPRING & FALL RINGERS – Men will play from the Blue Tees and Women will play from the Red Tees

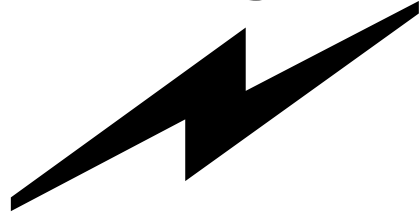
MEMBER – MEMBER – Men will play from the Blue Tees and Women will play from the Red Tees

Championship Flights – Men from the Black tees, Senior Men from the Blue tees and women from the Red tees.
